

Open account collection is a service where exporters and importers agree to pay by using the open account method. However, unlike in regular open account, documents must be submitted through the bank rather than directly to each other in order for the importer to accept the payment before getting the documents to bring the goods out of the port/airport. Payment will be made by the importer within 30 or 60 days of receiving the goods or the day the goods arrive.

Service Features

SCB offers an open account collection service by transferring export documents such as invoices, packing lists, bills of lading, and others to be collected through the importer bank once the goods have been dispatched.

Before delivering documents to the importer bank, the document examination service is offered to guarantee that they are accurate and in conformity with the collecting order. As soon as payment is received, you will be advised, and funds will be credited to your account.

Highlights

Shipping documents can be submitted to the importer bank within 4 hours.


